Experience

As an Educational Psychologist I have worked across the country in; Kirklees, Lincolnshire, Harrow, Greenwich and Cambridgeshire. I have experience in assessing and intervening with young people with a wide range of additional needs including:

- · Behavioural, emotional and social difficulties
- Physical difficulties
- Hearing impairments
- · Developmental delay/specific or general learning difficulties
- Attachment and abuse related difficulties
- · Anxiety, depression & school refusal
- · Language and Communication difficulties
- Autistic Spectrum Disorders/Asperger's Syndrome
- · Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)/Attention Deficit Disorder (ADD)

I am experienced in working in independent schools, special schools, academies and maintained schools and have also worked independently throughout my career. During this time, I have worked across the full age range (0-19) but specialise in the early years.

In 2003, I moved to the Cambridge and Peterborough Foundation Trust where I took up the position of Child Psychologist in the Child Development Unit. The role entailed working as part of a multi-disciplinary team of professionals (Consultant Paediatricians, Speech and Language Therapists, Occupational Therapists and Physiotherapists), assessing and diagnosing children (0-6) presenting with neuro-developmental difficulties, including Autism, ADHD, PDA and a variety of other complex syndromes. A combination of assessment techniques were used i.e. play-based and standardised (including the Autism Diagnostic Observation schedule) to assess children's strengths and difficulties as part of the diagnostic procedure. Early intervention to support parents and children following a diagnosis was an integral part of the role.

In 2015, I took up the position of Head of Therapy at a small Independent Special School for pupils with ASD. The school caters for a range of pupils including pre-verbal and high functioning, all of whom have complex learning patterns and challenging behaviour. I manage a team of therapists; who are based on site, including SaLTs, OTs and Learning Mentors. The team provides multi-disciplinary assessments for the pupils and deliver bespoke interventions throughout the school day. In-house training to support the staff to better understand all aspects of Autism also forms part of my role.

I am an accredited Elklan Tutor with the capacity to deliver the courses, 'communication support for children with complex needs' and 'communication support for verbal pupils with ASD', in conjunction with a SaLT.

I have also delivered the Emotional Literacy Support Assistant (ELSA) course to the Learning Mentors, which has already proved to be a successful addition to the schools training package.

In 2018, I trained as an Advanced Practitioner in Attention Autism www.ginadavies.co.uk and have delivered the training course to a team of SaLTs in Lincolnshire and Teaching Assistants at Park House School. I have also embedded the Attention Autism programme into the curriculum for the individuals that require this intervention.

Along with the interventions put in place, I have always ensured that the 40 hours continuing professional development that is required annually by the British Psychological Society is met, and often exceeded.
